Scholarship duration: 3 years

Curricula:

1. Nuclear and subnuclear physics
2. Quantum electronics and solid state physics
3. Applied physics
4. Theoretical physics

Admission procedures:

Ordinary merit list

The selection will be based on CV evaluation, a written test and an interview. The knowledge of the English language will also be verified. On request of the candidate the test and the interview can also be carried out in English. There will be a unique merit list and the scholarships will be assigned, among the various curricula, following the order in the merit list.

Foreign student merit list

For the scholarships reserved to foreign students, the selection will be based on CV evaluation and an interview on the research project proposed by the candidate. In this case, on request, the interview can be through

videoconference according to the procedure outlined in art. 16 of the call. There will be a separate merit list.

Scholarships not assigned to foreign students will be granted to candidates of the ordinary merit list.
